The **Re.ViCa Project** is carrying out a systematic review of institution-wide and cross-institution **Virtual Campus** initiatives of the past decade within higher education at European, national and regional levels.

Re.ViCa is looking not only at currently operational Virtual Campuses, but also at the legacy and impact of those initiatives that have ceased activities.

It is identifying relevant **Critical Success Factors** for aiming to ensure success in Virtual Campus deployment. A feature not common in EU projects is that it is analysing selected **non-European** initiatives also.

Re.ViCa also has an **International Advisory Committee** of experts and organises several discussion sessions at carefully chosen events to stimulate dialogue and share knowledge.

To ensure the success of the **in-depth case studies**, special care has been taken in the selection of the partnership with respect to Virtual Campus management experience.
